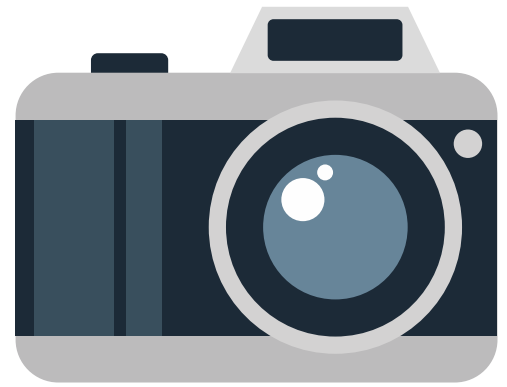


Photojournalist
