Creating a Time Capsule

Have you ever seen a time capsule? A time capsule is a container that is filled with items that describe someone's life. For example, your time capsule might have a movie ticket stub, a tennis ball, a drawing of your favorite app, or a photograph of important people in your life. Once time capsules are created, they are hidden away for a certain amount of time. They are then opened at a later date. Some time capsules are opened hundreds of years later! Today, will imagine you lived during the Civil War. You will create a time capsule with 5 items in it that will be opened at a later date in time! You will also write a description of why you included each item in your capsule.

Step 1: Choose an Identity

You will first choose a person who lived during the Civil War and imagine that you are them. You can choose a real historical figure, like George Washington. You can also create a fictional person, like a soldier named Joe who fought during the Revolutionary War. If you choose a fictional person, you should make sure that the information you provide is historically accurate.


