Every vehicle that travels on a road in the United States needs to have a license plate. Each state has its own license plate, which shows something important about that state. For example, Washington issues license plates that show endangered animals. Washington gives the money made from selling these license plates to their Department of Fish and Wildlife. People also personalize their license plates by adding license plate frames. - Each plate must include the state where it will be registered.

Step 4: Write Your Proposal

New license plate designs are approved by the state they are issued in. This means that first a new license plate is designed. Then, a proposal is written and submitted to the state government. Once it is approved, the plate design can be made available for sale. Write a letter to a state government representative proposing the three new license plate and frame designs you created. Your letter must meet the following requirements:

- Describe the three license plates and frames you are proposing.
- Explain why people may want to buy your license plates.
- Use proper letter formatting:
 - Include the date you are writing the letter at the top.
 - Start by addressing the group you are writing to (Dear State Government Representative,).
 - End with a closing and your signature (Sincerely, your name).
